Required Elements

1. Must include the Name of School: Cyrus J. Morris Elementary School
2. Must include: An International Baccalaureate School
3. Must include the School Year: 2010-2011
4. Must include the IB Logo
5. Must include the Matador Logo
6. Must include at Least 2 IB Attitudes
7. Must include at Least 3 of the IB Learners Profile
8. Must **NOT** include any copyrighted pictures
9. Must be on a 8 1/2" by 11" piece of paper done Portrait style
10. Must fill the complete page
11. Must include your name and room number on the **back** of the paper, NAMES PLACED ON THE FRONT OF THE PAPER WILL CAUSE YOUR ENTRY TO BE DISQUALIFIED
12. Must include at least three colors
13. Must not have any spelling errors

Your cover will be judged on how well you incorporate all the elements. Remember this is representing our school for the year.

Only the top two entries from each classroom will be forwarded on to the Student Leadership for the final judging.
